Clothing and Equipment List

A soft sided duffel bag is the preferred choice for packing clothing and equipment for camp. Please have your child help pack her clothing and equipment. This way she will know what she has with her and where it is located. Please be sure that each item is clearly marked with the campers name.

Do not send money, valuables or irreplaceable items.

Remember **NO** candy, gum or other food is allowed. It attracts small animals.

No radios or music players, hairdryers or curling irons. No cell phones - no reception!
